

Lime-S User Guide for Pilot Program in Ballantyne

[Lime](#) has launched a pilot program for its [electric scooters](#) (Lime-S) in Ballantyne, offering a convenient transportation option that supports our community's commitment to sustainability. As Lime-S is the only electric scooter share program in Ballantyne, the user guide below provides helpful information to ensure you have the best experience.

How Does Lime-S Work?

Lime electric scooters are GPS-enabled making it simple for riders to find, unlock and ride nearby scooters using the iOS or Android app. When the ride is finished, users simply lock the scooter and park responsibly.

Where Can I Park?

To make Lime-S the best experience for everyone, please use the following guidelines when parking your scooter:

- Always park the scooter upright.
- Do not park in the grass.
- Do not block pedestrian walkways or crosswalks.
- Do not block building entrances.
- Do not block ramps.
- Do not park in vehicle parking spaces or drive lanes.
- Do not park in decks.

How Much Does it Cost?

Lime-S costs \$1 to unlock, and just \$0.33 every minute to ride.
